The job:

You will be in charge of scaling our Finance functionality from a technical and operational point of view. Manual operations need to be reduced and eliminated where possible so that we are able to remove bottlenecks in our growth. Your technical and financial skills will be put to work in two specific areas:

Rolling Forecast model

This guides all our forecasting and decisions to optimise growth. Having gone through many iterations over the last four years, it's currently a complex integrated set of Excel files and Python code interrogating a SQL database. Your role will be to finish the migration from Excel to Python. Ultimately we would like an auditable, robust, automatically updated and parametric model.

Financial Flows

The information on our financial flows currently comes from disparate sources. We need a thorough and holistic system before we can build on top of them and drive insight. Two areas in particular will require work:

- Reconciliation of users transactions and balances
- Building a balance sheet management system



The Business Finance Engineer will work with the Group Finance Controller and other members of the finance team on automation projects to provide accurate ledger balances that feed our financial accounting systems on a regular basis.

Must-have skills:

- 3+ years of experience in an investment bank or a FinTech startup that has gone through very rapid growth
- High proficiency in professional modelling in Excel and Python. Please note that our requirements in Excel modelling are very high-- please do not apply if VLOOKUP is the best you know or if you cannot structure complicated system relationships in clear, auditable and parametric models
- Experience in defining and importing dictionaries, functions and classes in Python is essential (in particular using pandas and numpy libraries)
- Good SQL experience writing queries and procedures
- A demonstrated track record of building and optimising a company's financial data flows: the ideal candidate will have the capacity to optimise some flows themselves but also design with and express improvements for our back end engineers.
- An analytical and fact-based approach to problem-solving

You will personally be:

- Very comfortable in expressing complex business problems in simple quantitative financial models
- An excellent team player who will blend well with the rest of the organisation: this is extremely important for us in general and in this role in particular
- A driven self-starter who takes full ownership of and pride in their work
- Results-oriented, with a strong sense of purpose and high integrity
- Used to working successfully under tight project deadlines
- Someone with good leadership, project management and communication skills
- A strong team player, able to work in cross-functional engineering and ops teams
